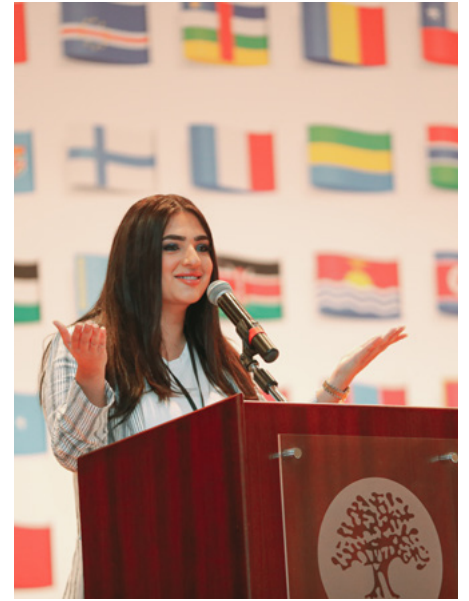
# Student Achievements

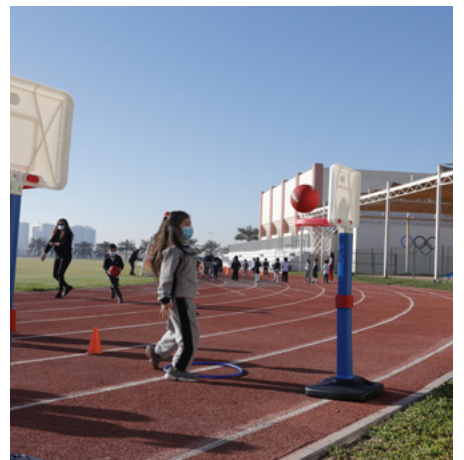




## Bahrain Sports Day
