#### **Arabic Poetry Night**



#### **SLO Mini-Conference**

This term's SLO Virtual Mini-Conference brought together more than 80 prefects from SABIS<sup>®</sup> schools in Manama, Doha, and Muscat. The conference proved to be a great learning opportunity that encouraged personal development and provided training to the prefects.

These online study sessions aim to support students academically and have proven to help students perform better.


### **Student Achievements**

#### Academic Milestones in External Exams

ISC-Manama senior students who undertook SAT I Exams in December 2020 have accomplished outstanding results globally. In comparison to previously globally published statistics, 83% of ISC-Manama students achieved scores above the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile, while 28% attained scores above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile. This implies that 83% of our students scored above 1210 in their SAT I Exam, compared to only 25% globally, while 28% of our students scored above 1340, compared to a minority of 10% in the world.

As for International English Language Proficiency tests (IELTS) required for university admission for non-native speakers, 68% of ISC-Manama senior students taking the exam achieved 7.5 and above which is higher than the requirement by top ranked universities worldwide.
