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Forever Green

In October 2021, Bahrain launched a nationwide tree planting campaign called Forever Green. This initiative is led by Her Royal Highness Princess Sabeeka bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa, the wife of the King of Bahrain and the Chairperson of the Consultative Council of the National Initiative for Agricultural Development. The Ministry of Works, Municipalities Affairs, and Urban Planning along with the Supreme Council for Environment (SCE) collaborated on the project.

The campaign aims to support the state's strategies through coordination with the public and private sectors to implement tree planting projects and expand the green areas in the country. Its objective is also to sustain the development of the agricultural sector in the Kingdom of Bahrain, highlight the aesthetic features of the country, and restore its historic agricultural legacy.

Our SLO Green Initiatives prefects learned about and participated in this wonderful initiative, furthering our commitment to environmental sustainability and contributing to the national afforestation campaign aimed at spreading awareness and enhancing green spaces across Bahrain.
